

INVITATION TO BID

Notice is hereby given that:

North Dakota Parks and Recreation Department

Will accept sealed bids for the construction of:

BEACH SHARED USE PATH – Phase II
City of Beach, North Dakota

All work shall be in accordance with the plans, drawings and specifications on file with the North Dakota Parks and Recreation Department.

One single prime proposal will be received for all categories of work at the offices of North Dakota Parks and Recreation Department, 1600 E. Century Ave Suite 3, Bismarck, ND 58503, until **1:00 p.m., C.T., Friday, February 27, 2015.**

The nature of the work and the type and location of the work is as follows:

- (1) Approximately 0.436 miles of paved Shared Use Path and associated improvements within the City of Beach, North Dakota;
- (2) Mobilization and Demobilization;
- (3) Clean up and disposal of any construction waste and materials.

The work required under the contract must be completed by September 30, 2015.

All envelopes submitted for a bid shall be securely attached together.

All sealed bids shall be opened at the offices of North Dakota Parks and Recreation Department, 1600 E. Century Ave Suite 3, Bismarck, ND 58503 at **1:30 p.m., C.T., Friday, February 27, 2015.**

In addition to the items specified in the Contract Documents, each bid must be accompanied by a separate envelope containing a bidder's bond in a sum equal to five percent (5%) of the full amount of the bid, executed by the bidder, as principal, and by a surety, authorized to do business in the State of North Dakota, conditioned that if the principal's bid is accepted and the contract awarded to the principal, the principal within ten (10) days after notice of award, shall execute a contract in accordance with the terms of the bid and a contractor's bond as required by law and the regulations and determinations of the North Dakota Parks and Recreation Department.

Each bidder shall have a valid North Dakota contractor's license of the proper class for the full amount of the bid, as required by § 43-07-05 of the North Dakota Century Code. No bid shall be read or considered unless a copy of a valid North Dakota contractor's license or certificate of renewal thereof is enclosed in the envelope containing the bid bond.

No bid will be read or considered if it does not fully comply with the terms hereof. Any deficient bid will be resealed and returned to the bidder immediately.

All contracts shall contain a provision requiring compliance with Executive Order 11246, entitled "Equal Employment Opportunity," as amended by Executive Order 11375 and as supplemented in Department of Labor regulations (42 CFR Part 60).

The North Dakota Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to reject any bid or to waive irregularity in the bids and in the bidding. The North Dakota Parks and Recreation Department further reserves the right to hold all legitimate bids for a period of sixty (60) days after the date fixed for the opening thereof.

The North Dakota Parks and Recreation Department, in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 U.S.C 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Transportation, Sub Title A, Office the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally assisted programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.
