Grahams Island State Park remains open

Grahams Island State Park remains open and will begin providing full services on May 20 along with the rest of the parks in the state system.

Reservations for Grahams Island State Park through the North Dakota Parks and Recreation Department website and call center are being postponed due to the rising waters of Devils Lake and the uncertainty of access. Camping sites are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Those interested in camping at Grahams Island State Park are asked to call ahead to the park at 701-766-4015 or email at dlsp@nd.gov to determine accessibility and campsite availability.

North Dakota state legislators provided \$2.9 million in matching funds to raise the road leading to Grahams Island. Federal and local funds are in place and the project will soon be bid. The department will continue to monitor the situation at Devils Lake and provide updates.

Grahams Island State Park will remain open as long as there is safe accessibility. NDPRD will work with local governments on possible closure of the Grahams Island road due to unsafe conditions.
