Sunday will wrap-up a wild weekend with a canoeing adventure starting at the warming house at 10 a.m. Come to Lake Metigoshe State Park this weekend, if you dare!

There is a 95 day window for making campsite reservations. To make a campsite reservation for July 29, you can start reserving your campsite on or after April 26. Approximately 50 percent of campsites are available for reservation, the rest are first come, first serve campsites.
