Concert under the Cottonwoods at Cross Ranch State Park

Cross Ranch State Park is celebrating the Labor Day weekend with a free concert by the bluegrass group Cottonwood on Sunday, Sept. 2, starting at 7 p.m.

Last year the park held a special Labor Day concert to mark its reopening after Missouri River flooding closed the campground for the summer. The turnout was so good it was decided to continue the concert this year with the locally renown bluegrass group Cottonwood returning as entertainment. The crowd will also get to sample Dutch Oven cobbler as prepared by North Dakota Parks and Recreation Director Mark Zimmerman.

The concert and cobbler are free, but Cross Ranch State Park's \$5 daily vehicle entrance fee will be in effect.
