Fort Abraham Lincoln holds April Fools Walk on April 1

This month's hike at Fort Abraham Lincoln State Park will be of the "photogenic" nature as participants endeavor to find and "shoot" unusual objects at the park on Sunday, April 1.

Since the hike is being held April 1, it is appropriately being called the "April Fools Walk," according to FALSP ranger Maureen Trnka. The event begins at 1 p.m. and runs until 2:30 p.m. During that time participants will be given clues to find and photograph several unusual objects that will be cleverly situated by park staff. The first to return with pictures of all the objects will be the winner of the April Fools Walk photo contest.

There is no charge for the event, but the \$5 daily park entrance fee applies and participants are asked to complete the self-registration at the park entrance, prior to meeting at the Visitor Center and to bring a digital camera, this includes cell phone cameras. While searching for the hidden objects, participants in the walk will get to tour the park on their own and experience the many features FALSP offers. There will be refreshments available upon the close of the hunt for the hidden objects.
