Volunteers needed to help clean up flood damage at Fort Abraham Lincoln State Park, April 21

Flooding devastated the Fort Abraham Lincoln State Park in 2011 and in hopes of reopening the campground this June a “Volunteer Clean-Up Day” is being held Saturday, April 21 from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Volunteer efforts will focus on restoring the campground area to its natural beauty. Participants are asked to dress appropriately for the weather, wear a good pair of work shoes, and bring gloves, shovels, rakes, wheel barrels, pitch forks, bug spray, water and food. Volunteers must be current with their tetanus vaccination.

The park’s vehicle entrance fee will be waived for all volunteers. Participants will meet at the large comfort station in the campground to check-in.
