Fort Ransom State Park updates master plan

The North Dakota Parks and Recreation Department (NDPRD) is updating its Fort Ransom State Park development master plan and is asking the public to participate by taking a survey related to the park.

Individuals interested in Fort Ransom State Park and in taking the survey can go to the NDPRD website at www.parkrec.nd.gov to complete the visitor use survey. The information is important to future development of Fort Ransom State Park which is located in the beautiful Sheyenne River Valley south of Valley City along Sheyenne River Valley National Scenic Byway.

Fort Ransom State Park opened in 1978 and the first master plan was completed in 1983. Significant developments have taken place in this popular state park over the past 30 years and updating the master plan will provide valuable insight for the future. Information received from the survey will assist Department staff with visitor use trends and provide direction for the park planning process.
