## **Fort Abraham Lincoln State Park continues clean up**

Clean up and repair of Fort Abraham Lincoln State Park is underway after spring flooding of the Heart and Missouri Rivers inundated most of the grounds in April. The park campground will be open by May 15, but modern sites will be without electricity, modern comfort stations and trailer dump station. It is possible the campground may be without these facilities for the Memorial Day weekend, May 22-25.

Visitors with campsite reservations are guaranteed their spot, but there will be no electrical hookup, comfort stations or trailer dump station. There will be vault toilets and water for campers. A partial reimbursement of the campsite fee will be made for those campers who arrive and use their reserved sites. The adjustment will be processed the first working day following your reservation.

The North Dakota Parks and Recreation Department appreciates your patience and understanding regarding the conditions at Fort Abraham Lincoln State Park following the unprecedented flooding the park experienced. Again, the department and park staff are doing everything possible to ensure visitors will have a safe and memorable experience while at Fort Abraham Lincoln State Park.
