Description of Proposed Project:

**The project will enhance 1.5 miles of walking and riding trails at the camp. The trails are primitive with no wear protection or handicap accessibility. We would like to improve the trails so the environment is not harmed, all weather use, and better accessibility. The walking trails cross two ravines and prevent some older adults and physically challenged youth from participating in portions of the trails. The walking trails with wood mulch average costs is \$2.00/ sq. foot. To apply to 1.5 miles would be \$15,840 in mulch materials. Walking bridges costs estimated at \$15,500. Labor estimate of cost would be \$4,500. Total walking trail costs are \$36,440. The camp is used by 4-H and other youth organizations and private rentals. Some ATV training is held at camp and the trails are used for those sessions.**
