




Groomed Ski Trail

Minot Park Board Minutes
November 19, 2013

The Minot Park Board met on November 19, 2013 at 6:30 PM in the Roosevelt Park Zoo Visitor Center.

Members Present: John Drady, Connie Feist, Richard Sabol, Cliff Hovda, and Robert Petry. Also present were Ron Merritt and Cindy Thomas.

The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Personal Appearances: None.

Randy Burckhard, Flood Recovery, appeared before the Board to present bids that were opened for flooded buildings. The first bid presented was for the Girl Scout Cabin in Camp Owetti. There were three bids received for the project. The low bid was received from Hight Construction in the amount of \$153,727.00. After discussion, motion by Petry, second by Drady to accept the bid from Hight Construction in the amount of \$153,727.00. On roll call, all members voted yes.

Discussion was then held on the bid opening for the Corbett Grandstand project. Burckhard recommended the project be rebid. After discussion, motion by Petry, second by Drady to accept the bid from Rolac Contracting in the amount of \$566,650.00. On roll call, all members voted yes.

Elly Deslauriers, marketing director, appeared before the Board to present the concept drawing for the Corbett Field scoreboard. She requested allowing advertisers to spread the \$23,000.00 payment over five years. She would like to be able to take the cost of the scoreboard from the Foundation, with the advertising payments going back into the Foundation. Hovda questioned if this would be a pledge scenario as opposed to a contract. Deslauriers stated she envisioned billing them annually for their payment. Motion by Drady, second by Hovda to allow the advertisers to spread their payments equally over five years. Feist felt the Foundation Board should be addressed as to what line item this money would come from. Motion carried.

Deslauriers then presented an updated plan for Centennial Park that includes trails on the south side of the river. She would like to apply for a grant from the North Dakota Outdoor Heritage Fund. Merritt stated this trail would fit in nicely with the parameters of the grant. Discussion was held with regards to the Centennial Park plan. Merritt stated the north side of the river would need to be discussed further. Motion by Feist, second by Petry to allow Deslauriers to submit a grant proposal to the Heritage Fund. On roll call, all members voted yes.

Motion by Feist, second by Hovda to approve the minutes from the October 15, 2013 meeting. Motion carried.

Motion by Drady, second by Feist to approve the bills in the amount of \$557,342.62. On roll call, all members voted yes.

Motion by Hovda, second by Petry to approve salaries in the amount of \$129,899.86. On roll call, all members voted yes.

Golf Committee Report: Hovda reported a committee had met concerning the interim golf course superintendent. They had reviewed the resume from Mike Chrest who had applied for the position. After interviewing Chrest, the committee would recommend offering the interim position to Mike Chrest. Motion by Hovda, second by Petry to move Mike Chrest into the position of interim golf course superintendent for a period of one year. Discussion was held on Chrest's qualifications. After discussion, motion carried.
