






Trail Map




Legend

Multi-Use Trail Rules & Safety

- There is no fee to use the Multi-Use Trail
- Current Registration and Liability Insurance is required
- Open to **registered** Class 1, 2, 3 OHVs (Max 60" Width)
- Motorized Vehicles must be insured
- Riders and Passengers under 18 must wear a DOT approved helmet
- Ages 11 and younger cannot operate OHVs
- Ages 12-15 must have an OHV safety certificate
- Ages 16+ must have a valid Driver's License
- Follow trail signage
- Respect private lands adjacent to trail
- Wear proper riding gear
- **STAY ON TRAIL**

Why do we close trails after it rains?

In order to maintain a safe & sustainable trail system, we close the trails following a significant rain event to allow the water time to shed off the trail. By doing this, rutting is minimized on the tread and it takes less time for the trails to re-open. The goal is to avoid damage to the tread & long term closures. We monitor the trails closely and open again as soon as possible. Call us for an update anytime or check our Facebook page for updates..
