

North Dakota Parks and Recreation Park System Grant Program (PSGP) Awards

The 68th Legislative Assembly of North Dakota appropriated one-time funding of \$6,000,000 as a matching grant program offered by the North Dakota Parks and Recreation Department (NDPRD). The Park System Grant Program (PSGP) provided grants for recreation projects such as ball fields, pools, campgrounds, playgrounds, and other recreation facilities utilized to support local park systems.
