

## Land & Water Conservation Fund Pre-Application

The Land and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF) is a 50/50 matching grant program administered at the state level by the North Dakota Parks and Recreation Department (NDPRD) and funded at the federal level by the U.S. Department of the Interior, National Park Service (NPS). The LWCF provides grants for outdoor recreation projects such as ball fields, pools, campgrounds, playgrounds, and land acquisitions for park development.

The following entities (only political subdivisions of the state of North Dakota with ownership of the project land) are eligible and may apply:

- Cities, Counties, and Townships
- Park Boards and Park Districts
- School Districts
- State Agencies

- Water Management Districts
- Federally-recognized Tribes

\*The pre-application is a new step in the grant process. It is not necessary to complete the pre-application in order to apply for the grant in the upcoming cycle; however, it is highly recommended. This pre-application is a tool to prepare grantees for the upcoming grant application. NDPRD will review all pre-applications and provide feedback to future applicants to help align expectations about the application and grant management.
