### Blaze Orange Hike Map

1. Trail will be on the multi-use single track trails starting at the south end of the Visitor Center Parking Lot. The trail first follows the Interpretive loop then connects to Little Solider, before cutting down through the hillside picnic area across the road to the Mandan On-a-Slant Village Sunken Gardens.
2. The trail is approx. a 2.5-mile loop trail ending though the On-a-Slant Village and back at the Visitor Center Parking Lot.
3. Hike will be active from Nov 8th through Nov 15th (7 Days).  
On Nov 7th the hiking trail map will be made available digitally via, Facebook, Email, or a link on FALSP's page on the NDPRD website [www.parkrec.nd.gov](http://www.parkrec.nd.gov)
4. On the hike there will be 1 selfie spot at the Sunken Gardens point along the trail. At this point you are required to take a photo that includes yourself/group. You will submit the photo to FALSP via 1 email to [falsp@nd.gov](mailto:falsp@nd.gov) by Nov 16th, and you receive your credit for November 2020 hiking challenge hike.
