



2021 ADVENTURE CHALLENGE

Visit some of North Dakota's most legendary locations to take tours, visit historic places, explore trails and experience outdoor adventures within the North Dakota Parks & Recreation Department (NDPRD) locations for your chance to win!

- ❑ Get outdoors and take a snowshoe selfie at a ND state park trailhead! Cross Ranch, Beaver Lake, Fort Stevenson and Lake Metigoshe have rentals available onsite.
- ❑ Explore the XC ski trails at a ND state park and snag a selfie with your skis on in front of a trailhead. Cross Ranch, Fort Ransom, Fort Stevenson and Lake Metigoshe have rentals available onsite.
- ❑ Take a snow angel selfie in front of any NDPRD location entrance.
- ❑ Visit Fort Abraham Lincoln State Park, locate the Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) worker statue and take a selfie with him!
- ❑ Grab your favorite sled and visit Lake Metigoshe, Turtle River, Icelandic State Park to take a few runs down a sledding hill. Don't forget to take a sled selfie at the hill!
- ❑ Visit Turtle River State Park and explore the trails, taking a selfie on the bridge between the Chalet and the Woodland Lodge.
- ❑ Head to Fort Mandan and take a selfie with Seaman, Lewis's Newfoundland dog that traveled along with the Corps of Discovery.
- ❑ Visit Fort Ransom State Park and take a selfie in front of the Sunne House.
- ❑ Travel to Lake Metigoshe State Park and hike the Old Oak, the state's first National Recreational Trail. Brochures for this self-guided trail are available at the office or in the warming house. Snag your selfie crossing the Oriole Island bridge.
- ❑ Visit Beaver Lake State Park, locate the cairn monument in Old Settlers Park and snap a selfie!
- ❑ Get outdoors and snap a selfie with a gorgeous sunset while visiting any of our locations.
- ❑ Visit the Lewis & Clark Interpretive Center and take a selfie in front of your favorite exhibit!
- ❑ Visit Icelandic State Park and walk amongst a number of restored historic buildings. Take a selfie in front of Hallson Church.
- ❑ Hike the self-guided Prairie Nature Trail at Lewis & Clark State Park and take a selfie at your favorite spot!
- ❑ Try stand up paddle boarding at Fort Stevenson, Icelandic or Lewis & Clark State Park. Rentals available at these locations.
- ❑ Fat tire bike at any North Dakota state park, taking a selfie with the bike at your favorite spot along the way. Fort Stevenson State Park has rentals available onsite.
- ❑ See what's going on at the fish cleaning station at Graham's Island State Park, taking a selfie at that location.
- ❑ Take a beach selfie at Beaver Lake, Grahams Island, Icelandic, Fort Stevenson, Lake Metigoshe, Lake Sakakawea or Lewis & Clark State Park.
- ❑ Camp at any one of the North Dakota state parks and take a selfie with your campsite in the background.
- ❑ Grab your fishing pole and visit a ND state park taking a selfie with your catch.
- ❑ Snag a selfie with one of our friendly staff members!
- ❑ Snap a Lake Sakakawea selfie at Crow Flies High State Recreation Area.
- ❑ Take a selfie kayaking at either Cross Ranch, Beaver Lake, Fort Stevenson, Fort Ransom, Icelandic, Lake Metigoshe, Lewis & Clark or the Pembina Gorge State Recreation Area. Rentals available on location.
- ❑ Wear your favorite NDPRD merch and take a selfie!
- ❑ Explore the trails at the Pembina Gorge and take a selfie at a trailhead.
- ❑ Head west to Sully Creek State Park and get a selfie taken along the shoreline of the Little Missouri River.
- ❑ Travel to Cross Ranch State Park to explore the self-guided Matah Trail. Brochures are available at the trailhead or visitor center. Snag a selfie with your brochure along the trail at your favorite stop.
- ❑ Find a geocache within a ND state park and take a selfie with it! Visit www.geocaching.com for cache locations or download the free app!
- ❑ Lake Sakakawea State Park is the western terminus for the 4,600 mile North Country National Scenic Trail. Locate its trailhead and take a selfie!
- ❑ Take a hot dog roasting selfie while visiting any ND State Park.
- ❑ Explore the TH trail at Little Missouri State Park to find the Thorris Sandvick memorial near the trailhead. Grab a selfie with it while visiting.
- ❑ Take a canoe selfie at a ND state park. Lake Metigoshe, Cross Ranch, Fort Stevenson, Icelandic, Fort Ransom and Lewis & Clark have rentals available onsite.
- ❑ Tour Fort Mandan, Ft. Lincoln Commanding Officer's Quarters or the On-A-Slant Indian Village, taking a selfie with your guide.
- ❑ Snag a selfie with your 2021 annual permit white visiting any of our locations! Annuals can be purchased (\$35) at your favorite ND state park or online via www.parkrec.nd.gov.
- ❑ Play on a playground at any ND state park and grab a selfie!
- ❑ Visit any of the ND state parks and take a selfie enjoying your favorite s'more recipe.
- ❑ Head to Fort Stevenson State Park and take a Guardhouse selfie.

2021 ADVENTURE CHALLENGE

Official Rules

- The 2021 Adventure Challenge officially begins at 12:00am on January 1, 2021 and ends at 11:59pm on December 31, 2021; participants can start the challenge at any time within that time frame.
- Participating locations include Beaver Lake, Fort Abraham Lincoln, Icelandic, Fort Ransom, Little Missouri, Turtle River, Lake Metigoshe, Lake Sakakawea, Grahams Island, Sully Creek, Lewis & Clark, Cross Ranch and Fort Stevenson state parks. Additional locations include the Lewis & Clark Interpretive Center, Fort Mandan, Crow Flies High State Recreation Area and the Pembina Gorge State Recreation Area.
- Challenge is open to all visitors. Entrants or a family member must have a Facebook account that should follow the *ND Parks & Rec 2021 Adventure Challenge* Facebook page.
- Adventure challenges are listed on a pinned post on the *ND Parks & Rec 2021 Adventure Challenge* Facebook page. Challenges can be completed in any order.
- Participants must take pictures, proving challenges were accomplished. Pictures must be submitted via private message to the *ND Parks & Rec 2021 Adventure Challenge Facebook* page from a single account.
- Limit one entry per household; entries must be submitted from a single Facebook account.
- Bonus adventures will be posted periodically to the *ND Parks & Rec 2021 Adventure Challenge* Facebook page and will have deadlines for which they need to be completed.
- Those completing bonus challenges posted on the *ND Parks & Rec 2021 Adventure Challenge* Facebook page need to complete the challenge and submit their pictures to prove their completion before the deadline. Failure to do so will result in no credit given towards that bonus challenge.
- All photos must be taken within one of the participating locations listed above; photos taken offsite will not satisfy completion of that specific adventure. Photos that are emailed, posted to the page or tagged referencing the challenge or account will not be accepted, nor count towards the overall challenge.
- One photo per challenge; each photo submission must reference the challenge it is intended to fulfill. No single photo will count towards the completion of multiple challenges. Additional photos submitted pertaining to a completed challenge will not increase chances of winning. The North Dakota Parks & Recreation Department will assume copyrights affiliated with challenge entries, enabling them to be utilized in promotional materials and shared on social media.

Prizes
