fill out the <u>online registration</u> form; email notification with payment instructions and deadline will follow; participants are not officially registered until payment has been processed.

Registration/Payment

Registration opens May 10 at 10am for all of the Summer OLC Day Camp Series; registration deadline is two weeks prior to each camp, unless camp fills prior. Pease register by visiting the online registration form. At the time of camp, participants need to be the age affiliated with the camp description. Participation is limited to 12 participants for each camp. The online form will determine the participants according to the date/time stamp; each camp will fill with the first 12 online registrations received. Additional online registrations will make up a waiting list of sorts. Participants can only be registered by their Parent/Guardians. A notification will follow via email with payment instructions. Participants are not fully registered until payment is processed. Should payment not be received by the deadline given, park staff will reach out to following online registrants on the waiting list and they will given the opportunity to register.

Drop-off/Pick-up

Participants should be dropped off each morning at Lake Metigoshe State Park's main office. Each day will end with 30 minutes of supervised free time at the beach, which is where participants need to be picked up. As a courtesy to both participants and LMSP staff, please be on time for drop-off and pick-up times each day. Should an issue arise, please contact the park at 701-263-4651.

State Park Entrance Fees

All vehicles entering any North Dakota State Park are required to subject to entrance fees. Daily entrance fees are \$7/vehicle; an annual permit is available for \$35, is valid through April 30, 2022 and waives entrance fees into all of the North Dakota State Parks. Entrance fees can be taken care of onsite or online.

Safety

Participants will be supervised during all activities and breaks. Participants will not be allowed to leave at any time during camp unless prior arrangements have been made with staff. Participants will not be allowed to leave with someone other than a family member unless prior notice is given. Please let staff know of alternative arrangements.

Messages

If you need to get a message to a camper and/or staff during camp, please call the main office for Lake Metigoshe State Park 701-263-4651 and leave a message. A courtesy phone call would be appreciated if your child is ill and will not be showing up that day for camp.

What to Bring

For participants' safety, experience and comfort level all should bring a backpack with several items to include, but not be limited to, a refillable water bottle, sunscreen, bug spray, hat/ball cap, sunglasses, extra change of clothes, swimsuit and beach towel.

Snacks/Lunch

Snacks and a healthy lunch will be provided. Please make sure participants have breakfast prior to camp to ensure they are ready for the day.

Beach Time

Our staff are <u>not</u> certified lifeguards; we will supervise participants at the beach and swimming area. Life jackets are available should any participants want or need them. Please let staff know ahead of time if there are any participants that cannot swim. If you are not comfortable with your camper spending time at the swimming beach in your absence, you may join us at the beach at 3:30pm. We'll assume all participants will be picked up at the beach unless we are otherwise notified. Should the weather not cooperate for beach time, participants can be picked up from the main office.

Parents/Guardians

Please be sure someone is available to pick up your child(ren) within 30 minutes should a situation arise such (illness, injury or disciplinary issue).

Disciplinary Actions

Park staff reserves the right to remove any participant(s) should disciplinary issues become a problem. In this case, the parents/guardians will be called and immediate arrangements will be made for that camper to get picked up. The participant will forfeit the rest of their time at the camp; a refund will not be made available.

Cancellation Policy

Refunds will not be available. Any participants that are ill or simply do not attend will waive registration fees, no exceptions. If, for whatever reason LMSP needs to cancel camp, full refunds will be available.

Weather Policy

Camp will take place rain or shine. Should weather not be ideal for planned outdoor activities, alternative activities will be planned indoors.


